Over \$110,000 in Major Grants Awarded!

The Calallen Education Foundation (CEF) provided educators an opportunity to request grant funds as soon as the school year started. In previous years, the major grants were only available in the Spring, but because of our generous donor partners, we were able to offer grants twice in 2019/2020! On September 24, 2019 the Fall Grant Patrol made up of CEF Board Members and the Calallen Wildcat Band created a parade across the district through all the campuses and awarded 11 grants totaling \$44,555.55.

Our Spring Grant Patrol had a unique twist this year. Originally scheduled for late March, the CEF Grant Patrol was cancelled due to social distancing requirements and the fact that teachers and students were working from home. But that did not stop the Calallen Education Foundation from delivering grants to deserving educators.

The CEF Board of Directors recorded special messages of congratulations to each grant winner and on April 9, 2020 the videos were sent to the winners informing them of their grant award. In all, 13 major grants were distributed totaling \$66,502!

Since 2011 the Calallen Education Foundation has awarded educators in Calallen ISD major grants totaling \$454,465.87. An additional \$11,937.60 has been awarded in mini-grants. None of this would be possible without the support of our donor partners. Thank you!
